## Kid Walk/Kid Talk Walk-a-thon Goes Virtual for Second Year

The Cumberland Scottish Rite of Freemasonry and the Children's League are proud to announce our **Second Annual "Virtual Kid Walk/Kid Talk Walkathon"** to support our local RiteCare Childhood Language Disorders Clinics. Thanks to your past generosity, these clinics are currently providing **FREE** RiteCare services to 28 children in Oakland, 24 in Keyser, and 36 in Cumberland.

We hope you will consider one of the several options to support this year's Kid Walk/Kid Talk Walkathon. You may participate by joining the Scottish Rite team to raise money from your friends and family and walk or run inside on a treadmill or outside anytime and place you choose between August 2, and September 18. Prefer not to walk? Just click or mail a "Walk with Me" donation of \$25 or more. Want to donate more? Consider being a \$250 "T-Shirt Sponsor" or a \$500 "Walk and Talk Friend Sponsor" and your logo will be featured on team T-Shirts and social media for the event.

While restrictions on public gatherings due to the Coronavirus pandemic may prevent this year's event from taking place in person, the **Virtual Kid Walk/Kid Talk Walkathon** will still provide the opportunity for supporters to enjoy a healthy walk or run while they raise funds to support the Children's League. This has been the format of this very successful annual fundraiser for more than 16 years. The online and virtual parts may seem like a clever new endeavor, but it has been done successfully many times by national charities such as the American Speech-Language-Hearing Foundation, (ASHA), and St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital.



As in previous years, supporters will register online or by mail to create or join a team and solicit pledges for their team from willing donors for the Walkathon. T-Shirts for each registered team member will be available for pick up at the Children's League on September 16-18 from 9:00 am until noon each day. Team participants under 21 will receive a team T-Shirt and those age 21 and over who donate \$50 or more are eligible for a T-Shirt upon request. Team members will be encouraged to sport their T-Shirts and walk on the date and time of their choice between August 2nd, and September 18<sup>th</sup>, sharing pictures of their walk on social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Etc.) with the hashtags #kidwalkkidtalk, #thechildrensleague, and, #scottishritecare. Awards will be presented to the three teams that raise the largest amount of donations.

While the number of clients we serve has increased by 60%, our ability to raise funds has been seriously hampered by Coronavirus restrictions and economic challenges to businesses that routinely donate but are presently unable. # Capping Ceremony and Feast of Tishri Slated for November 14<sup>th</sup>

I encourage all Scottish Rite Masons and guests to attend the Fall 2021 Combined Capping and Ring Ceremony and Feast of Tishri at the Cumberland Masonic Temple on Sunday, November 14<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 pm where the newest members of our Valley will be presented with their Scottish Rite Ring and Prayer Cap. This will be followed by the celebration of the Feast of Tishri, hosted by the Cumberland Council of Kadosh, which will feature a Thanksgiving style meal and the seven Toasts of Obligation. The cost of the meal is \$15/person and registration is available online at [cumberlandscothishrite.org](http://cumberlandscothishrite.org) or by returning the registration form below.

The origin of The Feast of Tishri is described in the book of Leviticus where it is said that the Lord spoke unto Moses, saying that on the fifteenth day of the month of Tishri of the Hebrew civil calendar, "ye shall have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the Lord." The Feast of Tishri is the Hebrew equivalent of Thanksgiving or Harvest festival.

The Feast of Tabernacles (Tishri) also commemorates the ceremonies of the completion and dedication of King Solomon's Temple, which began in the year 2992 A.L.\*, and finished in a little more than seven years. Six months after its completion, in the month of Tishri—the seventh month of the Jewish calendar—the temple was dedicated with reverential ceremonies to the one Living and True God (Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, Orient of Maryland, 2015). No other occasion epitomizes the character and purpose of the Feast of Tishri more wholly than the temple dedication. The rich legendry of the Temple's dedication, celebrated during the Feast of Tishri, is an essential part of the Fourteenth Degree.

By observing the Feast of Tishri, Scottish Rite Masons share the fraternal spirit and reaffirm our dedication to human concord and the brotherhood of all men. As Brothers, we resolve to build, as King Solomon did, peace for all mankind. We pray blessings upon you and hope to be honored with your presence.
